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Reading Florida Scrub-Jay bands

1) Get them to show their legs while facing you!
2) Read as a book: top to bottom then left to right.
3) Use a dash between legs.
4) There can be $0-4$ bands.
5) Some colors are difficult to distinguish when faded or in poor light. If difficult: state the first and second color choice. The only colors used are below. The right side are newer colors.

Every banded jay has 1 and only 1 silver band
A jay with no bands on left and a red, white, silver on right would be -RWS.

A jay with no bands on right and a red, white, silver on left would be RWS-.
